CITY OF YAKIMA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2021-2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider adopting the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and amending the Capital Facilities Element of the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan for the period of 2021-2026. The City annually prepares, reviews and adopts a program for transportation improvements to arterial streets for the ensuing six-year period, all as contemplated and required by state and federal law. After the Six-Year TIP is adopted, it will be incorporated as an amendment to the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan Capital Facilities Element.
