NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2023-2028

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider amending the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and amending the Capital Facilities Element of the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan for the period of 2023-2028. The City annually prepares, reviews and adopts a program for transportation improvements for the ensuing six-year period, all as contemplated and required by state and federal law. The TIP was adopted June 6, 2022 and amended with two additional projects on September 6, 2022. This Public Hearing is to consider adding three more projects to the TIP. After the Six-Year TIP is adopted, it will be incorporated as an amendment to the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan Capital Facilities Element. Said public hearing will be held **Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, in the Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2nd Street, Yakima, WA.
