## CITY OF YAKIMA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for 2017-2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct two public hearings to consider adopting the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the period of 2017-2022 and amending the Capital Facilities Element of the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan. The City of Yakima annually prepares, reviews and adopts a program for the construction of streets and arterial streets in the City of Yakima for the ensuing six-year period, all as contemplated and required by state and federal law. After the 2017-2022 Six-Year Transportation Plan is adopted, it will be incorporated as an amendment to the Yakima Urban Area Comprehensive Plan Capital Facilities Element.

Said public hearings will be held **Tuesday, June 7, and Tuesday, June 21, 2016**, both hearings to begin at 6:30 p.m., or soon thereafter, in the Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Yakima, WA.
