**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**DECLARATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider declaring certain property originally part of Drainage Improvement District #13 later abandoned by Yakima County to be surplus to City needs and abandoning all interest to the property owners over which the pipeline extends.

The property subject to declaration of surplus is a section of abandoned Drainage Improvement District (DID) #13 in the section of DID pipe from the vicinity of 1509 S. 15<sup>th</sup> St. to manhole 7A at the intersection of Mead Ave. and Rudkin Rd. The property was ceded to the City by Yakima County when the City accepted transfer of this conveyance system. The section of DID #13 sought to be surplus is no longer necessary as it was used for draining surface water from orchards, which have since been removed.

Said public hearing will be held on **September 11, 2018, at 6:30 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, in the City Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 N. Second St., Yakima.
