CITY OF YAKIMA NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Moratorium pertaining to Class 2 and Class 3 uses in the R-3 zoning district

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct a public hearing regarding an ordinance imposing a six-month moratorium on development of Class 2 and Class 3 uses within the R-3 zoning district in the City of Yakima, as outlined in Table 4-1 YMC 15.04.030; and setting December 8, 2020, as the date for the public hearing on the moratorium.

The City Council passed Ordinance No. 2020-030 on November 17, 2020, which shall be effective through May 18, 2021, for the purpose of preserving status quo and allowing time necessary to study and to develop appropriate zoning and land use regulations related to Class 2 and Class 3 uses, and their compatibility with the R-3 zone, within the city.

Said public hearing will be held on Tuesday, **December 8, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.,** or shortly thereafter, in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 129 North 2nd Street, Yakima, WA, for the City Council to receive public testimony and evidence regarding the moratorium, and to adopt findings of fact supporting the passage of this moratorium or modifying the terms thereof, as required by state law.
