NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
DECLARATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider declaring certain property originally part of Drainage Improvement District #4 later abandoned by Yakima County to be surplus to City needs and abandoning all interest to the property owners over which the pipeline extends.

The property subject to declaration of surplus is a section of abandoned Drainage Improvement District (DID) #4 in the section of DID pipe from manhole 32 in the vicinity of 1611 West Grant Avenue extending westerly approximately 595 feet to manhole 100L in the vicinity of 1807 Greenway Street. The property was ceded to the City by Yakima County when the City accepted transfer of this conveyance system. The section of DID #4 sought to be surplus is no longer necessary as it was used for draining surface water from orchards, which have since been removed.

Said public hearing will be held on **November 2, 2020 at 6 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, in the City Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 N. Second St., Yakima.
