**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
**DECLARATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yakima City Council will conduct a public hearing to consider declaring certain property originally part of Drainage Improvement District #39 later abandoned by Yakima County to be surplus to City needs and abandoning all interest to the property owners over which the pipeline extends. The property subject to declaration of surplus is a section of Drainage Improvement District (DID) #39 from manhole 11035 in the vicinity of 2605 Englewood Avenue extending northwesterly approximately 663 feet to manhole 11326 in the vicinity of 2708 Jerome Avenue. The property was ceded to the City by Yakima County when the City accepted transfer of this conveyance system. The section of DID #39 proposed for surplus is no longer necessary as it was used for draining surface water from orchards, which have since been removed.

Said public hearing will be held on **November 7<sup>th</sup> 2023, at 6:00 p.m.**, or soon thereafter, in person in the City Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 N. Second St., Yakima or via Zoom (information provided on the agenda).
