## **Speed Bump Projects to Impact Traffic on 31<sup>st</sup> and 35 Avenues**

Projects involving installation of speed bumps will impact traffic on sections of 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue for most of the day on Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>.

As a result of the projects, the sections of 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue and 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Summitview Avenue and Lincoln will be closed from 7:00 am to 3:00 pm on November 17<sup>th</sup>. Detour routes around the project areas will be available and will be marked with appropriate signage.

Drivers are reminded that the speed limit through all traffic-related works zones within the City of Yakima is 20 miles-per-hour.

During the projects, traffic delays in the affected areas are likely to occur. Drivers should use alternate routes until the project is completed.

Access to homes and businesses in the project areas will be maintained as best as possible.

As always, the schedule for these types of projects is subject to change daily dependent on weather, equipment failure, and emergencies.
