Traffic Signal Upgrade to Impact 40th Ave and Fruitvale Blvd

A traffic signal upgrade will impact the intersection of 40th Avenue and Fruitvale Boulevard for about two hours tomorrow morning, Wednesday, February 9th.

The 40th Avenue and Fruitvale Boulevard traffic signal will be out from 9:00 am to 11:00 am Wednesday so City crews can add battery backup capabilities to the cabinet at the intersection.

The intersection will be flashing red for up to 30 minutes with a brief period of total darkness as the power feed is changed over. There will be stop signs and/or police officers present to assist with traffic flow.

Drivers are reminded that the speed limit through all traffic-related work zones within the City of Yakima is 20 miles-per-hour.

As always, the schedule for this type of project is subject to change daily dependent on weather, equipment failure, and emergencies.
