City of Yakima Closures for July 4th Holiday

Many of the City of Yakima's facilities will be closed next Monday, July 4th, in observance of Independence Day.

That includes City Hall, Y-PAC, Public Works, the Harman Center, Law and Justice Center and Parks and Recreation offices.

Business offices for the Police and Fire Departments will be closed. Emergency services will remain available.

Yakima Transit will not provide bus service next Monday. Free shuttles will be available to and from 4th of July festivities at State Fair Park.

There will be no City of Yakima garbage pick-up service on Monday, July 4th. Garbage collection service schedules by the City's Refuse Division will be delayed by one day next week. Those with service scheduled for Friday, July 8th, will instead have their garbage picked up on Saturday, July 9th.

The one-day delay next week also applies to yard waste.

To ensure proper service, residents are asked to have their carts set out by 6:00 am.
