The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, April 16th.

Action by the Council yesterday included:

- Issuing a Tele-Communicators Week Proclamation.
- Issuing a Stand Against Racism Proclamation.
- Issuing a Cinco de Mayo Proclamation.
- Recognizing Walt Fridley of the Wastewater Division for an Apple Award.
- Approving a letter of support for Opportunity Industrialization Center.
