## **Asphalt Work to Impact Traffic on West Nob Hill Boulevard**

Asphalt repairs will result in traffic restrictions on a portion of West Nob Hill Boulevard from Wednesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>. Work on the project will begin at 7:00 am and should be completed by 3:30 pm each day.

The eastbound and westbound lanes of Nob Hill Boulevard between South 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue and South 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be restricted while the project is underway. Traffic will be channeled through the construction zone.

Because of heavy traffic volume, drivers can expect delays in the project area. Drivers should use alternate routes if possible until the work is completed.

Drivers are reminded that the speed limit through all traffic-related work zones within the City of Yakima is 20 miles-per-hour.

Access to homes and businesses in the project area will be maintained as best as possible and emergency vehicles will be allowed through the project area if necessary.

As always, the schedule for this type of project is subject to change daily dependent on weather, equipment failure, and emergencies.
