## **Yakima City Council October 17<sup>th</sup> Business Meeting Review**

The Yakima City Council held a regular business meeting yesterday, Tuesday, October 17<sup>th</sup>.

Action by the Council on October 17<sup>th</sup> included:

- Agreeing to continue discussion about the Community Integration and Ethics & Equal Rights Exploratory Committees at the next regular business meeting on November 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Approving temporary emergency cold weather shelters in the city of Yakima and allowing a faith-based shelter to operate during this time.
- Agreeing to lease City-owned property to Transform Yakima Together.
- Receiving the 2016 Yakima Police Department annual report.
