Yakima City Council February 19th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, February 19th.

Action by the Council yesterday included:

- Approving a contract with Next Step Housing for \$1 million of HOME investment funds to assist with land acquisition and development of the Bicycle Apartments.
- Authorizing an agreement with OIC of Washington for operation and maintenance of the Henry Beauchamp Community Center.
- Allocating \$75,000 in Lodging Tax funds to the SunDome in 2019.
- Authorizing open cruising events in 2019.
