## **Yakima City Council February 4<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting Review**

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, February 4<sup>th</sup>.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Issuing a proclamation on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Women's Right to Vote.
- Receiving an update on Council Boards and Committee assignments and clarification on mayoral committee designation.
- Declining to direct City staff to assist the strong mayor proponents in developing the proponents' charter amendment.
