The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Issuing a Martin Luther King Jr. Week Proclamation
- Receiving an analysis report on Washington Fruit Community Center
- Receiving a report on the second round of Community Development Block Grant COVID Fund program expenditures
- Directing City staff to present a resolution during the January 19<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting regarding remote public comment
