The Yakima City Council will hold a regular meeting at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

- A resolution approving extension of Mayoral Proclamation declaring an emergency order, if the Mayor issues a proclamation extending the civil emergency proclamation and order due to COVID-19

- Discussing special event permits
