The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, January 8<sup>th</sup>.

Action by the Council yesterday included:

- Issuing a Martin Luther King Jr. Day Proclamation.
- Announcing a special meeting from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm on Wednesday, Jan 30<sup>th</sup> at the Yakima Convention Center regarding a forum on H2A worker housing issues.
- Receiving Council committee reports.
