## **Yakima City Council July 11<sup>th</sup> Business Meeting Preview**

The Yakima City Council will hold its next regular business meeting at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, July 11<sup>th</sup>, in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North Second Street.

Agenda items will include:

- Consideration of an ordinance establishing an annual vehicle license fee of \$19 and fixing a time for it to become effective.
- Consideration of rescinding the City Council's vote on April 4<sup>th</sup> that terminated further consideration of an inclusive policing ordinance.
- Consideration of a resolution authorizing an addendum to the settlement agreement in the Montes, et al v. City of Yakima et al case.
- Consideration of a resolution authorizing approval of a Public Park and Recreation Facility and Development Agreement with SOZO Sports of Central Washington.
