## Yakima City Council July 18<sup>th</sup> Business Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council met for a regular business meeting last night, Tuesday, July 18<sup>th</sup>.

Action by the Council on July 18<sup>th</sup> included:

- Receiving a report regarding the proposed YMCA aquatics/fitness center facility at Chesterley Park and an update from the YMCA on its fundraising efforts for the proposed project.
- Discussion on the next steps regarding purchase by the City of property currently owned by Congdon Development Company, LLC.
- Authorizing contracts with Yakima Valley Partners Habitat for Humanity not to exceed \$165,000 of HOME Investment Funds to build four single-family residential units.
- Receiving an update on Camp Hope, a temporary homeless camp on City-owned property.
- Approving an airport-use agreement with the United States Air Force to lease property for the 2017 Mobility Guardian military exercise from July 31<sup>st</sup> to August 12<sup>th</sup>.
