Yakima City Council July 6th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, July 6th.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Recognizing the retirement of Police Officer Darryl Henning for 31 years of service
- Directing staff to bring back a proposed charter amendment to remove Council members for failure to attend City Council meetings
- Hiring a grant writer for the City of Yakima
- Directing staff to make police technology investments and hire two crime analysts
