Yakima City Council June 15th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, June 15th.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Recognizing the retirement of Joe Rosenlund, Streets and Traffic Operations Division Manager, for 12 years of service
- Approving an additional tourism promotion charge of \$2 per night of lodging stay.
- Directing staff to create a proposal using American Rescue Plan funds to address mental health issues in Yakima
- Authorizing the purchase of police vehicles
