Yakima City Council June 2nd Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, June 2nd.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Receiving a COVID-19 update from Interim City Manager Alex Meyerhoff.
- Ratifying a Mayoral proclamation of a temporary moratorium due to COVID-19 on enforcement of certain provisions in YMC 9.47 relating to parking violations for unlicensed vehicles and for 24-hour parking.
- Approving a resolution facilitating use of public spaces to accommodate restaurants and bars during COVID-19 emergency.
- Receiving a summary of home occupation permitting process and background.
