Action by the Council yesterday included:

- Observing a moment of silence for the victims of the shooting in Virginia Beach, Virginia.
- Proclaiming the week of June 10th as Juneteenth Freedom Week in the City of Yakima.
- Approving a resolution repealing the City's participation in the federal E-Verify program.
- Receiving reports from Yakima City Council committees.
