Yakima City Council March 17th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, March 17th.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Receiving an update on the City of Yakima's response to COVID-19
- Receiving the Yakima County Development Association's 2019 Report
- Issuing a Meals on Wheels March for Meals Proclamation
- Agreeing to discuss offering a permanent employment contract to Interim City Manager Alex Meyerhoff at the next regular City Council meeting, and requesting the City's Legal and Human Resources departments prepare recommendations for contracting.
