Agenda items for the March 20<sup>th</sup> business meeting include:

- Considering an ordinance repealing the City of Yakima Municipal Code chapter relating to Pitbull dogs.
- Receiving an activity update on the Yakima River Basin Integrated Water Resource Management Plan.
- Discussing a potential Sister City with Hadong County, South Korea.
