## Yakima City Council May 18th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, May 18th.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Receiving an announcement that City Hall and City facilities will re-open to the public on Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>. City employees and visitors who are fully vaccinated will not be required to wear masks.
- Agreeing to assist with up to \$15,000 for July 4<sup>th</sup> fireworks celebration at State Fair Park
- Approving letters of support for Yakima Housing Authority and the YWCA
- Requesting a report from staff regarding street racing
