## **Yakima City Council May 19<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting Preview**

The Yakima City Council will hold a regular meeting at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

Agenda items for the May 19<sup>th</sup> regular meeting include:

- Receiving a COVID-19 update.
- Issuing proclamations for Pride Month and Older Americans Month.
- Discussing interim and permanent City Manager review process and template.
- Discussing draft plan for utility bill relief in COVID-19 emergency.
