Yakima City Council May 4th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, May 4th.

Action taken by the Council yesterday included:

- Approving extension of Mayoral Proclamation declaring an emergency order due to COVID-19
- Issuing a Missing and Unidentified Persons Awareness Month Proclamation
- Receiving a presentation by Northwest Harvest regarding its new Yakima campus
- Supporting the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act
- Adopting the Community Crosswalks Policy
- Adding to the next regular meeting agenda the planning of a joint meeting of the Yakima City Council and the Yakima County Commissioners
