The Yakima City Council will hold a regular meeting at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, November 16th, via Zoom.

Agenda items for the November 16th regular meeting include:

- Introduction of Interim Assistant City Manager Matthew Selby
- Second public hearing on the 2022 Preliminary Budget
- Public hearing/ordinances for Ad Valorem Taxes to be levied in 2022
- Closed record hearing to consider an appeal of the Hearing Examiner's decision regarding a modification to an existing site plan for Apple Valley Elementary School
- Resolution authorizing a contract for \$750,000 of HOME Investment funds to support construction of a 16-unit farmworker affordable housing complex
