The Yakima City Council will hold a regular meeting at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

Agenda items for the November 17<sup>th</sup> regular meeting include:

- A COVID-19 update

- Considering a letter to Gov. Jay Inslee requesting inclusion of funding for Miller Park upgrades in the proposed budget.
- Holding the second public hearing on the 2021 Preliminary Budget for the City of Yakima.
