Yakima City Council November 19th Regular Meeting Preview

The Yakima City Council will hold a regular meeting at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, November 19th, in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2nd Street.

Agenda items for the November 19th regular meeting include:

- Issuing a 2019 Small Business Saturday Proclamation.
- Holding a second public hearing on the 2020 Preliminary Budget.
- Authorizing an agreement with the Rotary Club of Yakima for development of the Martin Luther King Jr. Park playground facility.
- Considering a proposition to submit to the voters on February 11, 2020 on whether the City Charter should be amended to abandon and abolish the Council-Manager form of government and adopt the Mayor-Council form of government.
