## **Yakima City Council October 2<sup>nd</sup> Regular Meeting Review**

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Action by the Council yesterday included:

- Reading a New Citizens Day Proclamation.
- Introducing Finance and Budget Director Steve Groom.
- Recognizing the City's Wastewater Division for receiving the "2017 Wastewater Treatment Plant Outstanding Performance Award" from the Department of Ecology.
- Receiving a report on the 2018 Council Mentorship-Internship Program.
- Approving the Upper Yakima River Comprehensive Flood Hazard Management Plan, 2018 Cowiche Addendum.
