The Yakima City Council will hold its next regular meeting at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, December 4th in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2nd Street.

Agenda items for the December 4th regular meeting include:

- Holding a second public hearing on the 2019 Preliminary Budget for the City of Yakima.
- Taking next steps following certified election results on the proposed Downtown plaza.
- Discussing capital facility needs and feasibility study for Lions Pool and Franklin Pool, and a possible new outdoor pool at Martin Luther King Jr. Park.
- Making appointments to City of Yakima boards and committees.
