Agenda items for the January 16th business meeting include:

- Declaring an emergency due to an impending landslide.
- Reviewing a resolution authorizing the City Manager to accept a SAFER Grant and increase the number of fulltime firefighters by 3.
- Reviewing the Yakima Business Incubator and Public Market Real Estate Study.
