## **City Seeks Public Comment for Draft Redistricting Plan**

The Yakima City Council will hold a public meeting at 5:30 pm on Tuesday, April 5<sup>th</sup>, for a draft redistricting plan. The meeting will be held via Zoom and in person at Yakima City Hall, 129 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

It was created by the City's Information Technology Services staff following Council review of redistricting proposals during a meeting on March 8<sup>th</sup>.

The redistricting proposal uses 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue as a general boundary for City Council Districts 3 and 4 rather than Nob Hill Boulevard.

It is the responsibility of the City to periodically redistrict based on population information from the most recent federal decennial census. Council must review and approve district boundaries before November 2022.
