## **Tree Project to Impact Downtown Parking**

Parking will be restricted at times near the former Bank of America building and the Yakima County Courthouse from Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, through April 10<sup>th</sup>.

The temporary restrictions will be required for a project to plant and replace trees around the courthouse and the former bank building near the intersection of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street and Staff Sgt. Pendleton Way. Project hours are 6:30 am to 3:30 pm Monday through Thursday from March 31<sup>st</sup> to April 10<sup>th</sup>.

Access will be maintained to properties in the project area.

Drivers are encouraged to slow down in work zones, look out for workers and follow the posted speed limit.

As always, the schedule for this type of a project is subject to change daily dependent on weather, equipment failure, and emergencies.
