## **Water Service Installation to Impact Traffic on 16<sup>th</sup> Ave**

Water service installation will disrupt traffic in the northbound and southbound lanes of a portion of South 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Tuesday, November 28<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, November 30<sup>th</sup>. Work on the project will take place from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm each day.

Traffic in both the northbound and southbound lanes of South 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Mead Avenue and Plath Avenue will be restricted while the project is underway. Traffic will be channeled through the construction zone.

Due to heavy traffic volume, drivers can expect delays in the project area. Drivers should use alternate routes if possible until the work is completed.

Access to homes and businesses in the project area will be maintained as best as possible and emergency vehicles will be allowed through the project area.

As always, the schedule for this type of project is subject to change daily dependent on weather, equipment failure, and emergencies.
