Subject: YFD discourages the use of gas-fueled turkey fryers in hot oil.

The Yakima Fire Department would like to <u>discourage</u> cooking your holiday turkey with an outdoor, gas-fueled turkey fryer which uses hot oil. The process of submerging a turkey in oil at a temperature of 350 degrees or more, on an open flame, elevated stand presents numerous safety hazards. Unintentional spills of boiling cooking oil could seriously burn or injure someone as well as place one's property at risk of a fire if the cooking pot is placed near combustible materials.

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) also does not encourage the outdoor, gasfueled in oil cooking method. The mission of the international nonprofit NFPA, established in 1896, is to reduce the worldwide burden of fire and other hazards on the quality of life by providing and advocating consensus <u>codes and standards</u>, <u>research</u>, <u>training</u>, and <u>education</u>.
