Narrative: On February 7, 2014 at 1744 hours Yakima Police Officers responded to 522 E. Yakima Avenue (Bank of the West) in reference to a robbery. The suspect fled the scene on a BMX bike according to witnesses. Several officers checked the area, but were not able to locate the suspect.

The investigation revealed that at approximately 1741 hours, the suspect entered the bank and handed a note to a teller demanding money and implying he had a weapon. The bank teller complied with the demands made by the suspect and gave him an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect left the bank on a bicycle.

The suspect was described as a white or Hispanic male approximately 5'07"/220 pounds. The suspect was wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt and gray stocking cap. The case was referred to the Yakima Police Department's Detective Division.
