## Yakima City Council August 22<sup>nd</sup> Study Session Review

The Yakima City Council met for a study session yesterday, Tuesday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Action by the Council on August 22<sup>nd</sup> included:

- Directing City staff to bring back information on a proposal to add parking meters along Yakima Avenue between 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets and along 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets between Yakima Avenue and Staff Sergeant Pendleton Way.
- Directing staff to bring back information on a proposal to close the City-owned parking lot north of Chestnut Avenue between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets for a period of seven consecutive days.
- Directing staff to prepare City Code amendments regarding nuisance weeds that were discussed during the study session for further consideration by the Council at a future Council meeting.
- Approving a resolution ratifying an Interlocal Agreement with Yakima County regarding a 2017 Justice Assistance Grant.
