## Yakima City Council December 5<sup>th</sup> Business Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular business meeting yesterday, Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup>.

Action by the Council on December 5<sup>th</sup> included:

- Approving an annual vehicle license fee of \$20, effective July 1, 2018.
- Eliminating the current cap on utility taxes that apply only to large-scale utility users.
- Issuing a World Aids Day Proclamation.
- Approving a non-project rezone submitted for property at 4201 Summitview Avenue.
- Establishing a permanent Community Integration Committee.
