Yakima City Council November 21st Business Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular business meeting yesterday, Tuesday, November 21st.

Action by the Council on November 21st included:

- Approving an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation to provide funding assistance for 20 new Fixed-Route transit bus shelters.
- Renewing a contract with Yakima Humane Society for animal control services in 2018.
- Receiving an update from Downtown Association of Yakima on 2017 events.
- Conducting the first of two public hearings regarding the proposed 2018 City of Yakima budget
