Yakima City Council October 16th Regular Meeting Review

The Yakima City Council held a regular meeting yesterday, Tuesday, October 16th.

Action by the Council yesterday included:

- Presenting a Domestic Violence Awareness Month Proclamation.
- Approving the top four priorities from the Public Safety Forums.
- Granting the Nob Hill Water Association a domestic water franchise.
- Agreeing to the Yakima Greenway Foundation's request for a Study Session.
