The Yakima City Council will hold its next regular business meeting at 6:00 pm on Tuesday, September 5th in Council Chambers at Yakima City Hall, 129 North 2nd Street.

Agenda items for the September 5th business meeting include:

- Discussing a revised draft letter to President Donald Trump regarding Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA).
- Discussing a letter to the Department of Social and Health Services supporting a YPAL grant application.
- Discussing retail marijuana in the M-1 Zoning District.
- Authorizing an interlocal agreement with the Yakima School District to continue the school resource officer program.
- Authorizing a state grant agreement to evaluate real estate options for a Yakima Business Incubator and Public Market.
