

## PLAYGROUND LEADER

**Duties:** Supervises program participants and leads the staff team in organizing and implementing a variety of youth activities involving arts, crafts, organized games, music, personal enrichment and sports activities around weekly themes. Assists with development of daily schedule of activities appropriate for youth ages 5- 12. Works with parents, volunteers and community agencies. Submit weekly reports. Purchase snacks and supplies. Submit timecards and reports weekly.

**Qualification Requirements:** Experience in childcare, instruction youth as well as managing a program for youth. Skills in organization and instruction of recreational events. Knowledge of organization and rules of cooperative and traditional games. Creativity is a plus. Ability to tactfully and courteously deal with staff, participants and general public. Experience in dance, drama, song, crafts or a sport is helpful.

**Licenses and Certifications Required:** Valid Washington State Driver's License. May require Standard First Aid and CPR certificates.

**Working Conditions:** Exposure to outdoor summer weather extremes. Lifting required.

**Hours of Work:** Flexible hours and shifts may be required. 30-40 hours per week for 6-10 weeks.

**Rate of pay:** \$11.00 per hour

**Minimum Class Requirements:** Any combination of education and experiences sufficient to understand verbal and written directions. Ability to lead children in a positive manner. Recreation planning or work helpful. College credit is preferable. All applicants must meet minimum requirements. In addition, qualified applicants may be further screened upon the major work characteristics and summary of duties specified in this announcement.
