Underground Storage Tank Removal Checklist

The applicant shall submit a completed Fire Permit Application Form and a site plan indicating tank(s) location(s) and size(s).

The applicant/contractor is responsible for complying with all NFPA standards applicable to the scope of work to be performed.

The applicant shall note on the application form the name of any third-party oversight providers, i.e. soil testing, compaction, etc.

The applicant/contractor is responsible for contacting the Department of Ecology to verify what/if any requirements they must comply with.

The applicant/contractor is responsible for contacting the City of Yakima Planning Division, 509-575-6183 or [.planning@yakimawa.gov](mailto:planning@yakimawa.gov) to confirm if a SEPA application is applicable, given the number and size of tanks to be removed.

The applicant/contractor is responsible for providing any applicable signage on the job site.

The applicant/contractor is responsible for providing the correct size and quantity of fire extinguishers at all times.

The applicant/contractor is responsible for obtaining an Excavation / Streetbreak permit, pursuant to YMC 8.72, for any work to be performed within the City Right-of-Way.

If applicable, the Contractor is responsible for contacting the City of Yakima Fire Department, 509-575-6060.

The permit fee is \$47.00 plan review and \$47 inspection fee, **per tank**.

The information provided herein shall not be construed to permit violation of any City, State and/or Federal laws. To insure that the information/requirements stated above have not been amended, please contact the Office of Code Administration at 509-575-6126 or codes@yakimawa.gov, to confirm current standards and/or codes.
