A proposal to enclose an approximately 1,700 square foot porch on a home located within the Barge-Chestnut Historic District located at 2608 Palatine Ave., has been determined to require a public meeting for review by the City's Historic Preservation Commission and determination concerning the issuance of a Certificate of Appropriateness in accordance with YMC Chapter 11.62.050.

Type II Review by the Commission is required for any proposed alteration of the appearance of a significant feature to a historic property to certify the changes as not adversely affecting the historic characteristics of the property which contribute to its designation.
