Pursuant to mutual labor agreement between the two above-listed parties, both parties agree that subsection (e) of Article 13 of the parties' Collective Bargaining Agreement that is effective from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2019, is hereby amended as follows:

Article 13-Shift Hours

(e) Officers shall be allowed to accumulate up to a maximum of sixty (60) hours of compensatory time. Compensatory time is defined as time off in lieu of overtime. including but not limited to, time off in lieu of paid overtime for court or callout time. Effective July 1, 2016, all accrued in excess of sixty (60) compensatory hours shall be cashed out on a quarterly basis.

Except as amended herein, the Collective Bargaining Agreement (effective from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2019) shall remain unchanged.
