Request: Proposal to construct a new 60,000 sq ft elementary school building in the R-1

zoning district with 147 parking spaces and other associated site amenities and improvements. This request includes a variance to exceed the building height limitation of 35 ft in this zoning district to allow a height of 44 ft, a critical areas review due to the site being in a wellhead protection area, and an administrative adjustment for the following: request to waive the sitescreening requirement that would impose a 6-ft view-obscuring fence, installation of a digital sign and wall signs which are not otherwise allowed in residential zoning districts, and adjust the maximum height of 10 ft for signs set back more than 15 ft from the right-of-way to

allow a height of 11 ft 6 inches.
